GENERAL INFORMATION

ADMISSION

Carmel is a co-educational institution and admission is open to all good and earnest students, irrespective of caste and creed. Admission will be granted only after appropriate oral and written tests and is subjected to age limit norms.

1. The principal has the absolute right to admit/deny admission. The decision of the principal shall be final and binding on the parents.
2. A child who joins fresh should submit the original birth certificate from the relevant Government Panchayath/Municipal authority in support of the date of birth entered in the registration form.
3. Pupils seeking admission from another school will be admitted only when a Transfer Certificate from the school he/she has attended, is produced.
4. Students coming from schools outside Kerala should produce the TC countersigned by the Educational Officer of the area in that state from where he/she comes.
5. Students coming from schools outside India should produce the TC countersigned by the Indian Embassy from where he/ she comes.

METHOD OF STUDY

The number of students in each class is restricted, in order to give each one maximum individual attention. This helps the students to carry out their major part of study in the classroom itself with the help of teachers and thereby reducing the quantum of work carried home. Activity - Oriented method is adopted at the Kindergarten level. We give emphasis to deeper formation of character and development of personality of students. A study / homework / activity timetable must be drawn up by the child with the assistance of the class teachers and the parents. At the Kindergarten level, the respective class teachers make a study timetable for the child. The variety in teaching/learning methods at Carmel Academy is geared to meet different learning styles of learners. We apply methods of active learning such as discussions, quizzes, collaborative learning and curriculum-based project work to stimulate higher order of thinking skills. A variety of reading and writing strategies are also made use of.



UNIFORM

- ◆ **The school uniform is compulsory for all the students on all school days and during official school functions unless indicated. Parents are requested to ensure that their ward comes to school in the correct and complete uniform. Otherwise, strict disciplinary action will be taken and also a fine will be levied.**
- ◆ Clothes must be clean and ironed, and shoes must be polished.
- ◆ Jewellery and gold ornaments are not permitted. Girls may wear simple ear-studs only.
- ◆ Only students of Grade V and above, are allowed to use watches. **Kindly avoid fancy watches.**
- ◆ **Girls with long hair should wear it in two plaits. Avoid fancy hair clips, hairbands, bindis, stylish haircuts etc. Boys should have only ordinary hair cut. Any other stylish hair cuts will be fined heavily.**
- ◆ Only **BLACK** hairbands, hairclips and rubber bands are to be used. No other colour is permitted.
- ◆ No special hair cuts are allowed for boys.

ATTENDANCE

Regular attendance in the class is expected from all the pupils. Any irregularity in this regard or absence without prior permission will adversely affect the evaluation of the concerned pupil and may involve disciplinary action.

Attendance on the date of opening and closing of school is compulsory. Students with full attendance will be rewarded.



SCHOOL FEES

Fee shall be received in three installments at the Carmel Academy **School office from 9.30 a.m. to 12.00 p.m. and 1.00 p.m.** The first instalment is to be paid at the time of admission (June). The second instalment is due in October and last instalment in January. The fees should be paid between 2nd and 10th working day of the month without fine and the last two working days with a fine of Rs. 25/-. All fees paid thereafter, will attract a surcharge of Rs. 100/- per term.

- If the fee not paid as per the given date, the promotion to the next class will be withheld.
- Fees once paid will not be refunded.

EVALUATION

There will be two mid-term evaluations or equivalent assessments, besides the terminal evaluations in the course of the year. Reports of all evaluations will be given to the parents appropriately.

Students found guilty of any malpractice will be subjected to stern disciplinary action.

A Best Performer Award is given to a child, based on child's involvement in academic, non-academic activities, in maintaining discipline and having exemplary character.

PROMOTIONS

Promotion is based on the cumulative performance level of the work done during the year. continuous assessment will be done on classwork, home-work, projects, worksheets and tests.

Promotion will be based on the whole year's work, on regular attendance, on the overall development, assignments and the assessments conducted throughout the year.

With regard to promotion, the decision of the school authorities will be final.

All are expected to do their work punctually and dutifully.

After monthly evaluation, an Open House Programme will be arranged to facilitate the parents to get a first hand information about the performance/short coming of their children. Parents are to meet the teachers with their son/daughter at the scheduled time.

PARENT-TEACHER-WELL WISHERS' ASSOCIATION

The PTWA Association aims primarily at ensuring effective co-operation among all concerned i.e. the Management, Staff, Parents and benefactors of the school, eventually involving in the developmental activities of the school.

Apart from the P.T.W.A., Mother P.T.A. has also been formed for the developmental activities of the child.



FACILITIES PROVIDED

1. **Computer :-** The school has made adequate arrangements to impart basic education in computer application with the help of professionals in the respective field.
2. **Library :-** The school has a well equipped library with a complete collection of latest Encyclopaedia. Students are encouraged to use the library facility extensively both for reference and home reading.
3. **Science Laboratories:-** The school maintains well-equipped separate laboratories for Physics, Chemistry, Botany and Zoology.
4. **Children's Amusement Park:-** This is a special facility provided for Kindergarten children to make their first learning experiences in the school, pleasant and memorable.
5. **Training in Games and Athletics:-** Vacation camps and after-class coaching are arranged with the help of professionals to develop skills and talents of our students in various games.
6. **Talent Scan Programmes:-** Weekly Special Coaching is given to the students to develop their innate talents. Students get opportunity to choose one item from a variety of options like use of Yoga, Zumba, Keyboard, Robotics, Roller Skating, Karate, Abacus etc.
7. **Stadium :-** The school possesses one of the finest stadiums in the state, of international standards with 8 lane 400 m track. The track encloses a fine football ground and it is attached with a magnificent pavilion. These infrastructural facilities are not only utilised by our students, but also kept open to the general public for useful purposes.
8. **Home Theatre:-** The school has to its credit, a fully air-conditioned home theatre and LCD projection. This facility is used to teach especially English language and science subjects.
9. **Digital Classrooms:-** Interactive whiteboard-installed classrooms have been set-up to make teaching and learning, competitive and interesting.
10. **Clubs:-** To encourage the interests of the students in different fields, clubs like Nature Club, Science Club, Mathematics Club,



Philately Club, Quiz Club and Literary Club are organized. Students are encouraged to enrol themselves in any one of them, according to their interest.

11. **Conveyance:-** For the convenience of the pupils, the school operates buses. Children will be picked up and dropped at prefixed points.
12. **Special Training:-** The talented pupils are trained by professionals on the first and third Saturdays.
13. **Language Lab:-** The English Language Lab facility is arranged to instil a new perception to understand English Language with correct sounds, stress, intonation and the pause patterns in an authentic way.
14. **German Language Class:-** The school has arranged a special coaching on German language on select Saturdays by well-trained German tutors.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

All efforts made by the school authorities with regard to education and formation of the students can bear fruit, only with the co-operation of the parents. Hence the parents should ensure that

- (a) Children attend school in the prescribed uniform with the required books.
- (b) Children get enough time at home for self study and assignments.

A good deal of information is passed through the handbook and therefore parents are advised to check the diary everyday.

1. All the students are expected to speak English during school hours with a view to promote excellent communicative skills in English.
2. Students must bring the school handbook to school everyday.
3. The full school uniform with the identity card must be worn everyday. A student without proper uniform will not be allowed to take part in the school activities.
4. Scribbling on walls and furniture is strictly prohibited.



5. During the school hours, students are not allowed to use the school telephone and neither are they allowed to be called to answer phone calls. However, in case of illness the school authorities will call the parent.
6. Electronic items like mobile phones, smart watches, pendrive, CD etc are strictly forbidden.
7. Books such as magazines, comics etc. should not be brought to the school. No article liable to be a source of disturbance should be brought to school.
8. Bad behaviour and use of offensive language will be severely dealt with.
9. Students must maintain silence in the school. They must maintain discipline when moving from one class to another. They should move in a single line only.
10. No student will be excused from physical education without a Doctor's Certificate.
11. Students are not allowed to give presents to the teachers or staff of the school.
12. Students on their birthday they are allowed to wear a dress other than the school uniform and voluntarily donate a book/informative CDs to the school library, to inculcate the habit of reading and sharing.
13. Students should take care of their belongings, especially money. School is not responsible for the loss of such things.
14. Students should be regular, courteous, well-behaved, disciplined and clean in their dress and habits.
15. A student who is persistently found to be insubordinate, wilfully mischievous, and guilty of misconduct or has unwholesome influence on fellow students, is liable to be expelled from the school.
16. A student is responsible to the school, not only for his/her behaviour in the school, but also for his/her general behaviour outside.



17. During the absence of the teacher, the Class Prefect or Leader will be responsible for the order and discipline of the class.
18. Students are expected to keep the school premises clean and protect school property from damage.
19. All students must be regular and punctual. Every student should reach the school before the first bell which is at 8.50 a.m.
20. No student shall be permitted to go home during the school hours without the written request by the parent/guardian in the prescribed form and the permission of the principal.
21. Habitual negligence in work, disobedience and acts of misconduct will invite severe disciplinary action including expulsion.
22. Any damage caused to the property of the school will have to be made good.
23. Any student found using foul language or caught fighting will be dismissed from the school.
24. Children suffering from contagious diseases will not be allowed to attend the class.
25. Assignment should be done regularly and carefully and submitted at the appointed time.
26. Pupils of one class are not allowed to enter other class rooms.
27. Playing in classrooms and corridors is strictly prohibited.
28. When passing along the corridors during the class hours, students shall maintain silence.
29. Every pupil shall endeavour to keep up the high standard and prestige of the school by excelling in studies, good manners and other school activities.
30. Pupils who are absent for five consecutive days without obtaining leave of absence and fee defaulters will have their names removed from the rolls. Refer 'School Fees' for further details.
31. Cycles and other vehicles parked in the school premises are at the owner's risk.



32. Pupils absent from examinations without genuine reason will be considered as failed. **There is no provision for re-examination of the missed tests.**
33. Attendance during official school function like the School Annual Day, Sports etc., is compulsory.
34. Students are to obtain prior sanction in the prescribed form before availing leave.
35. Students absenting themselves in emergency situations are required to submit 'Leave Application Form', the very next day. In case, a student happens to be absent for 2 days in one and the same month, the parent has to report to the principal's office and explain the reason. If a student cannot attend classes due to hospitalization, the matter should be reported to the principal's office immediately and a certificate from the doctor concerned should be produced on the first day to school after recovery.
36. Every student is to make a choice, with the consent of parents in one item in sports, games or cultural activities as a part of the Talent Scan programme. Parents are advised to ensure the participation of their sons/daughters in the select item.
37. The receipt issued from the office on payment of school fees, bus charges etc. should be produced whenever asked for.
38. The Management, Principal and staff will not be held responsible in any way for any accident or mishap that may occur to the students in the school premises while bringing the students to the school or taking them back by bus. Sick students should not be sent to the school.
39. Parents or guardians will not be allowed to visit their children during class time. In emergency they should report to the Principal. They can meet the teachers only during the visiting hours.
40. No school business will be transacted on holidays and at the residence.



41. All students are expected to participate in the study tour programmes and picnics arranged by the school.
42. Leave application should be written in the model of the leave proforma given in this handbook.
43. The school has arranged Group Insurance for all the students. For details and procedure, parents can contact the school office.
44. Change in the address or telephone number of parents or guardians must be intimated to the school in writing and without delay.
45. Fine of any kind or collection or sale for any purpose, whatsoever requires the prior sanction of the Principal.
46. Students should greet one another, the visitors and the teachers of the school when they meet them.
47. Honesty is expected of every pupil. If a pupil finds something which does not belong to him/her, he/she should inform the Principal of the articles found and leave the same in the office. Pupils who lose the articles may also enquire about them in the office.
48. Punctuality is the key to success. Late comers should meet the Principal and their names must be entered in the late coming record.
49. Girls are not allowed to wear second stud and if found so, strict action will be taken.

A SPECIAL NOTE TO PARENTS

- i . Parents are requested to bear in mind that the school attaches great importance to building a sound character in students. They are expected to co-operate with the school authorities by making their children understand that a well-ordered and disciplined way of life is as important at home as in school. Parents should supervise their lessons, and take an active interest in the activities of the ward.



- ii. The purpose of discipline is not to punish but to teach children how to behave in socially acceptable ways, and how to cope with natural emotions like anger, frustration and jealousy.
- ii. A child feels wanted when parents hug him/her and say they love him/her.
- iii. An important part of development of the child's self confidence is to make him/her feel accepted at all times.
- iv. Even if a child has not shown much skill, praise the effort made. Appreciation helps the child to try further.
- v. Instead of using threats to deal with misbehaviour, suggest what he/she could do to behave in the appropriate way.
- vi. Parents help to develop independence in children where they let the child do a task on his/her own. You may give suggestions to the child while he/she does the project work/assignments etc., but never do it for him/her.
- vii. Dealing with children is a tough and demanding task. Children are sometimes easy to get along with, sometimes very difficult. When parents pay attention to children's feelings and help them to handle these feelings, they feel respected. This gives them a sense of self worth, which enables the child to deal with similar difficulties more effectively.



Each student must have a copy of this handbook and bring the same to school daily. Parents and Guardians are informed, that occasional reports from the teachers are conveniently sent through these pages. Any memo sent from school has to be counter signed by parents.



INSTRUCTIONS TO THE STUDENT

1. Boys/Girls are not allowed to grow their nails.
2. Shirt buttons should not be kept open and the shirt to be tucked in properly, irrespective of the dress. Belts to be worn tightly and visibly.
3. Clothes must be clean and ironed, and shoes must be polished.
4. Wearing jewellery and gold ornaments will not be entertained. Girls may wear simple ear-studs only.
5. Girls are not allowed to wear second studs and if found so, strict action will be taken.
6. Girls with long hair should wear it in two plaits. Wear only black hair bands (if hair is short).
7. Girls are not allowed to wear off-shoulder dress, short and tight tops.
8. Only modest dress will be permitted in school.
9. Personal hygiene is to be maintained.
10. Colouring of hair or using hair gel is not permitted.
11. Hair style should be according to the norms of the school, Fringes and hair strands covering the forehead will not be permitted.
12. Designs, line arts, writing, patching, paintings or pictures on pants or shirts are not allowed.
13. Children are not allowed to bring and use mobile phone/any other electronic device in the campus. Items will not be returned if found.
14. Torn jeans and low waist pants are not permitted in the campus.
15. Alteration in stitching uniforms will not be allowed.
16. Using coloured contact lens is strictly prohibited.
17. Bringing/using of chewing gums, pan parag, alcohol, tobacco items, drugs, soft drinks and eatables etc to the school is strictly prohibited.
18. Tattooing is strictly prohibited.
