The present situation of the Corona Virus (COVID 19) pandemic is unrelenting and seems to be getting worse in many parts of the Country. While a large number of schools have started and are doing excellent work in the field of online teaching, continuing with the scheduled syllabuses for all Classes, especially at Board level, there are an equally large number of schools which are not able to do so for various reasons.
